Exclusionary rule: suppression of illegally obtained evidence

Human dignity



ECHR *Khan v. UK:* illegally obtained evidence may not lead to an unfair trial

•Probative value



Trial-fairness test: if the data can be *contradicted*, is not the *sole basis* for the conviction, is *reliable*, and does not emanate from *coercion*



Issues of legitimacy and the promotion of an undemocratic rule of law



No immunity

Data protection violations give rise to liability: GDPR



A task in the public interest (Art. 6(1)(e) – can justify the sharing



Obstacles to the use of art. 6(1)(e)
